

## 11 Additional Policies

### 11.12 Wraparound Care (was After School Club Policy)

#### Policy statement

We offer two Extended Hours Clubs – Early Drop Off Club (EDO in conjunction with The Colleton School) and After School Club (ASC). We are able to offer spaces to children Monday to Friday on a first come first served basis for EDO and Monday to Thursday for ASC. A waiting list will be held for the other children who may like to join the clubs. Funded hours cannot be used at the EDO or ASC (a child with an EHCP may use some of this funding towards ASC).

The Clubs provide a mix of adult-led and child-initiated activities. The Club always follows play principles, allowing children to choose how they occupy their time and never forces them to participate in a given activity.

#### EDO Procedures

- Operates from 8-8.45am, Monday to Friday at The Colleton School. Booking must be made via pre-school but the form returned to the school.
- Children will be walked over to the pre-school at the end of the session by an additional member of staff.
- No breakfast is provided

#### ASC Procedures

- Operates from 3.15 until 5.45pm, Monday to Thursday at the pre-school.
- Run by pre-school staff and is a continuation of the children's day.
- A large snack is provided between 4 and 4.30pm.

#### Legal framework

Little Acorns Extended Hours Clubs are committed to meeting the requirements of the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage 2023 (EYFS). EYFS applies to all children from birth through to the end of their reception (Foundation) year. More information about EYFS is available from the Department for Education's website.
